Request for Review and Recommendation for Preliminary Approval of Proposed Amendments to Chapter 4-72, Hawaii Administrative Rules, "Plant Intrastate Rules," to Prohibit the Intrastate Movement of *Metrosideros* (all species in genus) (Ohia) Plants and Plant Parts, Including Flowers, Leaves, Seeds, Stems, Twigs, Cuttings, Wood, Logs, Mulch, Greenwaste, Frass, and Soil, All of Which are Known Hosts or Carriers of the Fungus, *Ceratocystis fimbriata*, Known to Cause Ohia Wilt (Rapid Ohia Death), From the Island of Hawaii to Rapid Ohia Death Restricted (Non-Infested Islands) Except by Permit Issued by the Hawaii Department of Agriculture (Department). *(Proposed Permanent Rule to Replace Department Plant Quarantine Interim Rule 15-1 Approved 8/25/2015.)* **(See Attached Summary of Proposed Amendments.)**

Summary of Proposed Amendments to Chapter 4-72, Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), the Hawaii Department of Agriculture's Plant and Non-Domestic Quarantine, Plant Intrastate Rules, Relating to Regulating Intrastate Movement of Plants, Generally, and Soil.

Amendment to chapter 4-72, HAR, is proposed to add a new section section 4-72-___ entitled: Restrictions on ohia and soil from rapid ohia death infested areas. The proposed permanent rule would replace Hawaii Department of Agriculture Plant Quarantine Interim Rule 15-1, approved August 25, 2015. The proposed rule would establish a permanent guarantine to prohibit the intrastate movement of Metrosideros (all species in genus) (ohia) plants and plant parts, including flowers, leaves, seeds stems, twigs, cuttings, wood, logs, mulch, greenwaste, frass, and soil from the island of Hawaii, known to be an island infested by Ohia Wilt (also known as Rapid Ohia Death, to non-infested islands of the State, except by permit issued by the Department and subject to conditions consistent with preserving the quarantine, including science-based testing and, if appropriate, treatment. The rule describes generally the conditions under which the regulated material may qualify for intrastate shipment. The proposed rule is necessary to prevent the further spread and establishment of a specific strain of Ceratocystis fimbriata, a fungus known to cause a wilt disease in ohia lehua. Ohia trees make up about 50% of the biomass of Hawaii's native forests. A massive dieback of Hawaii's native forest could have very damaging effects on native flora and fauna and adversely impact the State's groundwater systems.
