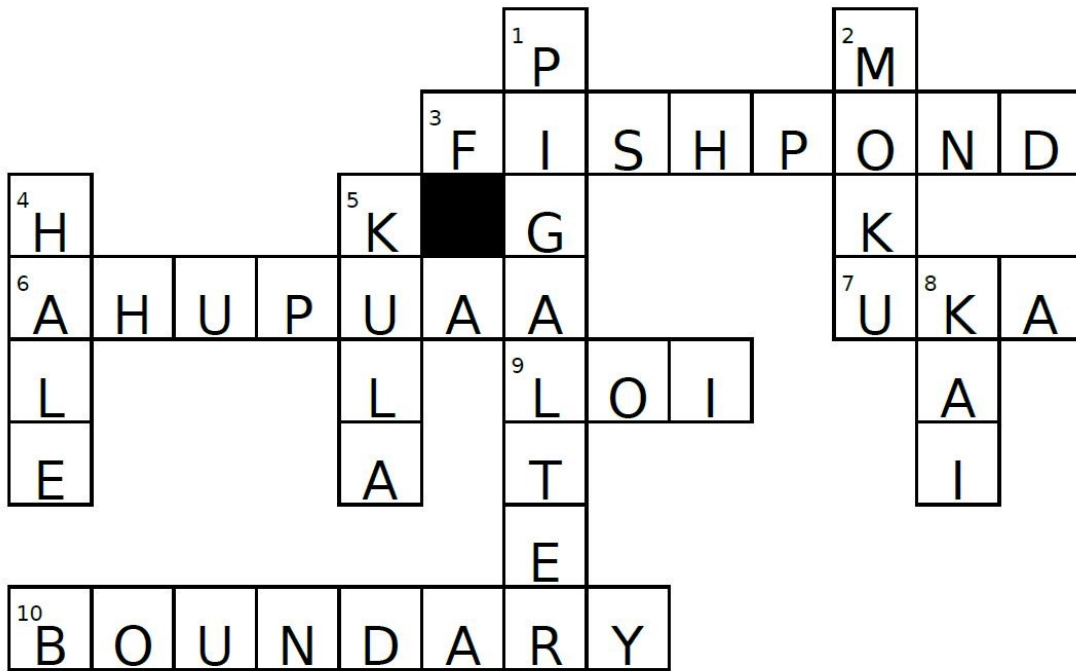


# Hawaiian Land Divisions

### Down:

- When ahupua'a is directly translated from Hawaiian to English it says...
- Large section of divided land. O'ahu has 6 of these.
- Hawaiian word for house
- The section of the ahupua'a where most people lived and is used for growing food.
- The section of the ahupua'a that is closest to the ocean and where fishponds are found.

### Across:

- Called a loko i'a in Hawaiian, these were built at the edge of land with rocks walls that have gates in them.
- A smaller area than a moku. The boundaries of this were usually set by high ridges and ran from mauka to makai.
- The highest section of the ahupua'a is where the water is collected.
- A wetland kalo (also known as taro) patches in which fresh water from streams are used to grow the crops.
- A general term for a dividing line that marks the limits of an area.
